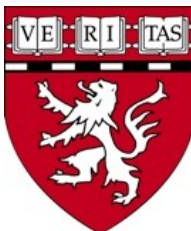

He attended Chicago Medical School and earned his MD with Distinction in Research. He completed his orthopaedic surgery residency at Loyola University Medical Center in Chicago serving as a chief resident his final year. He continued his specialization in spine surgery by completing the Harvard Orthopaedic Spine Surgery Fellowship at Massachusetts General Hospital & Brigham and Women's Hospital. He was awarded The Charles M. Schwartz, MD, Traveling Fellowship and received additional training in spine surgery at the University of New South Wales in Sydney, Australia.

Dr. Fogel is currently an instructor in orthopaedic surgery at Harvard Medical School and participates in the surgical training of orthopaedic residents and orthopaedic spine surgery fellows. His research interests include modulating factors of bone fusion after surgery as well as patient safety and quality improvement. Dr. Fogel currently serves on the AAOS Patient Safety Committee and co-leads the Massachusetts General Hospital Enhanced Recovery After Surgery (ERAS) team for spine surgery.
