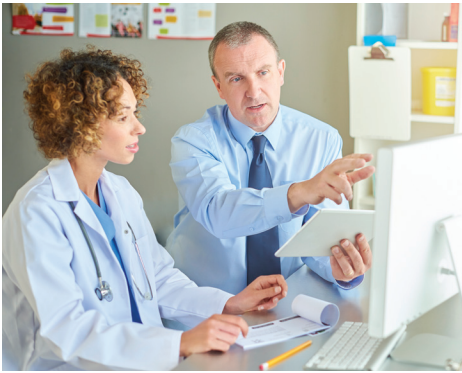




# TeleDermatology Program



The TeleDermatology Program provides consultative support to physicians through virtual access to Mass General dermatologists. Your physicians receive timely medical consultations to assist in the treatment and triage of dermatological cases. Physicians are empowered to treat cases that are appropriate for management by a primary care physician (PCP) and refer cases that require a specialist to treat. This program is designed to both augment existing dermatology services experiencing capacity issues as well as provide access to care where access is currently limited or unavailable.

## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

### STEP 1 Submit Case



Place a consult request (using your smart device) through the Portal and include images of the lesion, rash, etc.

### STEP 2 Telehealth Consultation



The Mass General attending will review the consult request and images within a 24-hour period and provide a written consult via the Portal.

### STEP 3 Documented Interaction



You will receive a consult note from the Mass General attending providing an opinion on the nature of the lesion, rash or skin issue, as well as recommendations on treatment and follow-up care.

## BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATION
